Mayor's Office, City Hall, Brooklyn, September 15th, 1881.

\$5,000 Reward will be paid by the City of Brooklyn for the apprehension and conviction of George A. W. Stuart, charged with embezzling school moneys belonging to the City of Brooklyn. The sum of \$2,500 will be paid for the apprehension and delivery of the said Stuart into the custody of the proper authorities of Brooklyn, and the additional sum of \$2,500 will be paid for his conviction upon the charges of embezzlement. For the information of the public, the following description is given of the said Stuart:—His age is 45 years, his height 5ft. 9in., fair complexion, full sandy beard, no moustache (which may have been changed), slightly bald in front, shoulders slightly stooped; wearing black prince albert coat and vest, probably light pantaloons, white straw or black derby hat. Said Stuart absconded from Brooklyn on Sunday, 7th September instant, was accompanied by his wife, Mrs Rachel Stuart, about 45 years of age, weight about 200lbs., stature about 5ft. 5in., fair complexion, rather pale face, hair black, dressed in black.—James Howell, Mayor.

The Superintendent of Police, Brooklyn, has received information that the offender is settled on a farm 12 miles from Melbourne.

Offender was Secretary of the Board of Education in the above city, and in that capacity embezzled a quarter million dollars. He is accompanied by his brother-in-law, a Mr. Mitten, and his wife and child. Offender has no children.—O. 4869, 10th August, 1883.
