

## O'CONNOR, Charles Yelverton (1843-1902)

The O'Connor family is best known in Western Australia through Charles Yelverton O'Connor. O'Connor was responsible for Engineering the Mundaring to Kalgoorlie Water Supply and the inner Fremantle Harbour. Originally from Ireland, he went to New Zealand and performed contract work for private groups as well as Government schemes. His lineage is interesting in itself and many of the deposited papers refer to his family and ancestors.
