

RANFORD family papers

Benjamin Bristow Ranford (b. 29 September 1826 in England) came to South Australia in 1848 and to Western Australia in 1851. He was a tanner and currier, employed at first in this State by William Padbury but later took over the business. On 28 June 1853 he married Sarah Ann Summerland (1832 - 1891): they had six sons, including Henry Samuel (1854 - 1934) and Benjamin Summerland (1862 - 1941) and four daughters.

Henry Samuel Ranford was a Surveyor, Government Land Agent, Inspector of Lands and Services (Acting Surveyor General) & Emigration Officer in London (1909).

Benjamin Summerland Ranford lived at some time at Nedlands and later at Bannister.
