

RAILWAY OFFICERS' UNION

The Australian Services Union (ASU) was formed on 1 July 1993 following a ballot of members in favour of amalgamation of the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, the Federated Municipal and Shire Council Employees Union of Australia and the Australian Municipal, Transport, Energy, Water, Ports, Community & Information Services Union which was also known as the ASU at the time.

In May 1992, the West Australian Railway Officers' Association (WAROU) voted strongly in favour of amalgamation with the ASU. In October 1992 it joined the ASU and its members now form the Rail Industry Division within the ASU, WA Branch.
