

TANNER, WILLIAM, 1801-1845

William Tanner (1801-1845) arrived on the "Drummore" on 1st February 1831 with his wife Hester, nee Viveash (1804-1846), and a son, William Afric (1803-1911). William Tanner was allowed to select 35,000 acres and took up locations in the Swan and Avon districts. He farmed on the Upper Swan at his property, "Baskerville Estate". The family left the colony to return to England on the ship "Napolean" on 14 January 1844. The three Tanner children born in Western Australia were baptized in the Parish of Calne, Wiltshire, UK in 1844.

William's sister, Eleanor, (1803-1842) married Charles Baskerville Viveash in 1824. The couple emigrated to Western Australia, later moving to Tasmania and returned to England in 1836.

Henry William Afric Tanner, (11 March 1868-19 March 1934), was the grand-son of William and Hester. He was born at Ealing, UK and migrated to Western Australia in 1888. He worked as a jackaroo on the Dempster property at Northam, he moved from there to Tableland and thence to Coolgardie, finally settling at Beverley. Henry died at Perth in 1934.
