

Claremont.—A residential district on Rivor Swan 9 miles from Perth and Fremantle with station on E. ry., fars 11d. and 6d.; ret. 1s. 4d. and 9d. Churches, C.E. Govt. school. Post Office, mail twice a day.

Cleaverville.—A townsite at Port Robinson N.W. Division.

Coates.—A stopping place on E. ry. 42 miles from Perth.

Collie.—A station on S.W. ry. 102 miles from Perth and 13 from Bunbury, fares from Perth, 17s. and 10s. 8d.; return 25s. 6d. and 16s. Agricultural and boring for coal.

Condon.—A Post and Telegraph Station in N.W. Division about 165 miles from Roebourne.

Cookerway Brook.—A railway station on S.W. Ry. 80 miles from Perth.

Coolgardie.—A mining township on the Yilgarn Goldfield about 120 miles Eastward from Southern Cross. P.O. Telegraph line to be constructed shortly. Banks, Commercial, Union, and W.A. Newspaper, *The Coolgardie Miner*.

Coolup.—An agricultural district and station on S.W. Ry. 62 miles from Perth.

Coorinja.—A fruit-growing district 10 miles from Clackline on Newcastle branch of the Eastern Railway.

Cossack.—A municipality and the principal port of the N.W. District, and for the Pilbarra Goldfield. Situated about 8 miles from Roebourne, connection with which is by tram. Church, C.E. service. Government Schools. Post, T., M.O.O., & S.B. Pearling.

Cottesloe.—A suburban district 4 miles from Fremantle and 8 from Perth; fares from Perth 1s. 2d. and 8d., ret. 1s. 9d and 1s.

Cranbrook.—A railway station on G.S. Railway 66 miles from Albany; fares 11s. and 8s. 3d.; return 16s. 6d. and 12s. 3d.

Cuballing Pool.—A siding on G.S. Ry. 187 miles from Albany; fares 31s. 2d. and 23s. 5d., ret. 46s. 9d. and 35s. 2d.

Cue.—A mining township on the Murchison goldfield about 260 miles N.E. from Geraldton. Telegraph line in course of construction. P.O. Fortnightly mail. Newspaper, *Murchison Miner*. Banks, Union and W.A.

Dale Bridge.—A stopping place on E. ry. 91 miles from Perth.

Dandaragan.—Near Yatheroo, Melbourne district. Govt. school.

Dangin.—About 25 miles S.E. of York.

Dardanup.—A siding on Boyanup railway line 10 miles from Bunbury. Churches, R.C. Schools, Govt. and R.C. Post Office.

Darkan.—An agricultural area on the Arthur River W. of Wagin, G.S. Ry.

Darlington.—On E. Ry., 15 miles from Perth.

Daudabin.—About 5 miles from Northam. Govt. school.

Daylekering.—P.O. Weekly mail.

DeGrey River.—A squatting district. Post Office.

Denison.—A townsite situated at the mouth of the Irwin River.

Derby.—A seaport town on King Sound and a port for the Kimberley goldfield. Churches, R. C. service, Post, T., M. O. O. & S.B. Pastoral and Shipping.

Dingup.—In Blackwood district. Govt. school.

Dongarra.—A township near the mouth of the Irwin River S. of Geraldton and a railway station on Midland railway 45 miles from Geraldton, fares 7s. 7d. and 5s. 4d.; return 11s. 6d. and 8s. 2d. Churches, C.E., Wes. Govt. schools. Post, T., M. O. O. and S.B. Weekly mail.

Doodlekine.—A townsite on Yilgarn railway. Post and Telegraph office.

Drake's Brook.—A station on S.W. railway 60 miles from Perth, fares 11s. 8d. and 7s. 4d.; return 17s. 6d. and 11s.

Dundas Hills Goldfield.—The South of & adjoining the Yilgarn goldfield. Tracks from Esperance Bay on S. coast about 110 miles and Fanny's Cove about 130 miles; also from Coolgardie about 100 miles.

Dunsborough.—See Quindalup.

East Fremantle.—Part of Fremantle with Station on Eastern Railway, fares from Perth, 1s. 7d. & 11d. return 2s. 5d. & 1s. 6d.

East Perth.—Part of Perth with platform on E. R. about 1/2 mile from Perth Central Station, fares 3d. & 2d.; return. 6d. & 3d.

East Mount Magnet.—A mining centre on Murchison goldfield.

Eastwood.—A siding for the Eastwood Estate distant 7 miles from Albany on G.S. ry., fares 1s. and 9d.; return 1s. 6d. and 1s. 2d.

Edwards' Crossing.—A stopping place on Eastern Railway, 95 miles from Perth.

Egina.—A mining district on the Pilbarra goldfield, about 30 miles S.E. of Mallina and 40 miles from the coast.

Esperance Bay.—A natural harbour on the South Coast about 240 miles E. of Albany. Schooner service from Albany and Adelaide. Homestead of Dempster Brothers. Track hence to Dundas Hills about 110 miles and thence to Coolgardie. Post and Telegraph office.

Etipup.—An agricultural settlement 3 miles W. of Broome Hill, G. S. Ry. Churches. C. E.

Eucla.—A townsite on the Great Australian Bight on the Eastern border of W.A. Constant vessels from Albany and Adelaide. Post and Telegraph office.

Ewlyamartup.—An agricultural area on G.S.R., N. of Broomehill.

Eyre.—A post and telegraph station on the South Coast in Eucla division about midway between Israelite Bay and Eucla.

Fanny's Cove.—An inlet on S. coast about 200 miles E. of Albany. Schooners from Albany. Track hence to Dundas Hills goldfield about 130 miles and thence to Coolgardie.

Ferginson, R.—About 15 miles S.E. of Bunbury in Wellington district. Churches: C.E. serv., Wes. serv.

Fitzroy R.—King Sound.

Fortescue R.—Roebourne district. Post and Telegraph office.

Fremantle.—A port and municipality on the West Coast at the mouth of the Swan River. Fremantle is the Western terminus of the Eastern ry. and is distant 12 miles from Perth, fares 1s. 9d. and 1s.; return 2s. 6d. and 1s. 6d. There is a direct service of steamers and sailing vessels from London at frequent intervals. Steamers to and from the Eastern Colonies (see advts.) also steamers to and from Singapore via intermediate ports monthly. Fremantle is connected with the Capital by road, railway, river, telegraph and telephone. Churches: C.E., R.C., Wes., Con., Pres., S.A. Schools: Govt., R.C. and Private. Banks: "Commercial," "National," "Union" and W.A. Post, T., M.O.O. and S.B.

Gascoyne.—A pastoral district on Gascoyne River.

Geraldton.—A port and municipality on W. coast on Champion Bay about 210 miles by sea N. of Perth. Terminus of Northern ry. Churches: C.E., R.C., Wes., Pres. serv. Schools: Govt. and R.C. Banks: "National," "Union," and "W.A." Newspapers: *Victorian Express* and *Geraldton-Murchison Telegraph*. Post, T., M.O.O. and S.B. Weekly mail. Shipping, pastoral and agricultural. Depot and starting point for mining districts.

Geraldton Racecourse.—Six miles from Geraldton on N. ry., fares at ordinary times 1s. and 8d.; return 1s. 6d. and 1s.

Gilgering.—On E. ry. 87 miles from Perth. P.O. Daily mail.

Gingin.—A municipal township and station on Midland ry, 50 miles N. of Perth, Churches: C.E. and Wes. Govt. Schools. Post, T., M.O.O. and S.B. Mail twice a week. Agricultural.

Gladstone.—A townsite on Sharks Bay about 80 miles S. of Carnarvon.

Gledhow.—A townsite on G.S. ry. 3 miles from Albany, fares 6d. and 5d.; ret. 9d. and 8d.

Glengarry.—A sheep station 22 miles from Geraldton. P.O. Weekly mail.

Golden Valley.—A mining district on the Yilgarn goldfield about 35 miles N. from Southern Cross.

Gooseberry Hill.—A stopping place on Upper Darling Range ry. 9 miles from Midland Junction, fares 1s. 6d. and 1s.; ret. 2s. 3d. and 1s. 6d. Govt. school.

Gregsons.—A siding on E. ry. 70 miles from Perth, fares 11s. 5d. and 7s. 1d.; return 17s. 2d. and 10s. 8d. Govt. school.

Greenbushes.—A tin-mining centre and township 52 miles S.E. of Bunbury and 9 miles from Bridgetown. Mail coach twice a week. Church: Wes. serv. Govt. schools. Post, T., M.O.O.

Greenhills.—About 10 miles S.E. of York. Church: C.E. serv. P.O. Weekly mail.

Greenmount.—A townsite and siding on E. ry. 13 miles from Perth, fares 1s. 11d. and 1s. 1d.; ret. 2s. 11d. and 1s. 8d.

Greenough.—A township 22 miles from Geraldton with station on Midland railway, fares 4s. 1d. and 2s. 7d.; ret. 6s. 3d. and 3s. 11d. Churches: C.E., R.C., Wes. Govt. Schools. Post, T., M.O.O., and S.B., Weekly mail. Agricultural.

Guger's.—A vino-growing district with platform on E. ry. 22 miles from Perth.

Guildford.—A municipal township on River Swan 8 miles by rail from Perth, fares 1s. 2d. and 8d., ret. 1s. 9d. and 1s. Churches: C.E., R.C., Wes. Schools: Govt. and R.C. Post, T., M.O.O., and S.B., mails 4 per day. Agricultural and residential.
