BARRISTERS' BOARD.

MEMBERS.—The Attorney General and the Crown Solicitor; *ex officio* Mr. S. H. Parker, q.c., as Queen's Counsel; & Mr. J. Horgan, the Hon. A. B. Kidson, Mr. E. Sholl & The Hon. F. M. Stone, elected members.

Secretary—Walter A. Gale.

This board is established by virtue of "The Legal Practitioners Act, 1893," and has power to regulate and control the examination and admission of articled clerks and the examination of all candidates for admission to the Bar of the Colony. The certificate of the board is necessary before any person can be admitted to practice.

Clerks are required to pass the usual preliminary examination in General Law, and to serve articles for a period of five years, or in the case of a person who has taken a degree in any British or Colonial University, a period of three years.

Barristers and solicitors of England or Ireland, and Writers to the Signet and Solicitors of the Supreme Court of Scotland, are entitled to be admitted to the courts of this colony, and so also are Solicitors admitted in any colony where (i.) the law is similar to that administered in this colony, (ii.) service under articles of examination are required, and (iii.) where practitioners of the Supreme Court of Western Australia are entitled to be admitted. Every person applying for admission must first reside for 6 months in the colony and satisfy the board of his fitness, lodge with the Secretary for five months his papers in complete form, advertise notice of his application, and pay the board 30 guineas. On admission a further stamp fee of £10 is payable.

The board has power to inquire into complaints against practitioners for illegal, unprofessional, negligent, dishonest or extortionate conduct, and to make a report to the court thereon. The court awards such punishment or otherwise on the report as to the court seems meet.

Copies of the rules made by the board, under the Legal Practitioners Act, 1893, may be obtained upon application to the Secretary, or may be referred to at any Law Institute Library.
