PERTH HIGH SCHOOL.

The affairs of the school are managed by a Board of Governors appointed by the Governor of the Colony

Two annual scholarships are offered for competition amongst boys under 14 years of age attending Government schools; these scholarships were valued at £50 prior to 1st January 1896; they

are now £75 & are tenable for 3 years at the Perth High School

Western Australia has no university. The Perth High School was established by statute in 1876 (40 Vic., No. 8), & is endowed to a certain extent out of the general revenue—by the grant of an annual sum equal to double the amount of the school fees—provided such contribution does not exceed £500

The Governors are a corporate body & are empowered to hold lands, goods & benefactions in trust for the school. They are six in number & are appointed by the Governor in Council (55 Vic., No. 25) & are endowed with power to make by-laws & regulations for the management of the school

The instruction is exclusively secular & the head master must be a graduate of a recognised University, but not a minister of religion

By the Medical Act the Governor-in-Council may appoint or remove a Medical Board, consisting of not less than three nor more than seven members of the medical profession to whom persons desirous of being registered must submit their degrees, diplomas, certificates or other proofs. The board on due proof of qualification, skill, & ability to practice medicine or surgery, & also that the applicant practitioner is entitled to receive from the Registrar of the Medical Board a certificate of his registration of January. No person other than a medical practitioner is allowed to practice medicine or surgery, or to profess to be a medical practitioner, or to pretend that he is qualified to so practice.
