DISTRICT ROADS BOARDS.

The formation, construction, and maintenance of the public roads throughout the Colony, excepting those within the boundaries of a municipality, is intrusted to the cure of local boards appointed to represent the several road board districts into which the Colony is divided, and which it is optional for the governor to designate, define, or alter, at any time, by notice in the Government Gazette.
