Circular Notes are issued by its Branches, in sums of £10, £20 and £50, negotiable by its correspondents in the chief Cities on the Continent of Europe, in North and South America, Ceylon, Mauritius, India, China, Japan and Africa. Share Registers are kept at Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane, Adelaide, Hobart and Launceston, and at Wellington, New Zealand, to any of which English and Colonial Shares can be transferred—the Bank affording every facility to its Proprietors for this purpose. Dividends are paid upon receipt of telegraphic advice.
