Two annual scholarships are offered for competition amongst boys under 14 years of age attending Government schools; these are worth £75 & are tenable for 3 years at the Perth High School Western Australia has no university. The Perth High School was established by statute in 1876 (40 Vic., No. 8), & has an endowment of £1,000 payable out of the general revenue. The Governors are a corporate body & are empowered to hold lands, goods & benefactions in trust for the school. They are six in number & are appointed by the Governor in Council (55 Vic., No. 25) & are endowed with power to make bye-laws & regulations for the management of the school. The instruction is exclusively secular & the head master must be a graduate of a recognised University, but not a minister of religion.
