Precedency.

By the sixth chapter of the Rule and Regulations of the Colonial Office, in the absence of Colonial Enactments, of Royal Charters, of Instructions, communicated either under the Royal Signet and Sign Manual, through the Secretary of State, or of authoritative usage, the following table of precedence of Colonial Officers is to be observed:—
The Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Officer administering the Government.
The Senior Officer in command of the Troops, if of the rank of a General, and the Officer in command of Her Majesty's Naval Forces on the Station, if of the rank of an Admiral, their own relative rank being determined by the Queen's Regulations.
The Bishop.
The Chief Justice.
The Senior Officer in command of the Troops, if of the rank of Colonel or Lieutenant-Colonel, and the Officer in command of H.M.'s Naval Forces on the Station, if of equivalent rank, their own relative rank being determined by the Queen's Regulations.
The Members of the Executive Council.
The President of the Legislative Council.
The Members of the Legislative Council.

The Puisne Judges.
