**ABBAY NULLIUS OF NEW NORCIA,** Diocese of Perth.—Founded originally 1st March, 1846, by the two Spanish Benedictine monks, Reverend Fathers Joseph Serra & Rosendo Salvado; it is about 82 miles north from Perth. Established as an Abbey Nullius 12th March, 1867. The territory does not exceed 16 square miles

in area & immediately surrounds the abbey. Lord Abbot, Right Rev. Rosendo Salvado, D. D., O.S.B.; consecrated Bishop 15th August, 1849 & nominated Lord Abbot by His Holiness Pius IX., 12th March, 1867; Abbot Conductor & Prior (with right of succession), Very Rev. F. Dominguez O.S.B.; Vicar-General, Very Rev. Y. Bertran O.S.B.
