The Eastern Group of Goldfields is connected with the harbour of Fremantle, from which a Government Railway extends as far as Menzies. The distance from Fremantle to Southern Cross, via Perth, is 248 miles; from Southern Cross to Coolgardie 180 miles, and from thence the Boulder are connected to Kalgoorlie by branch lines the former being distant 12 miles and the latter 3 miles. From Menzies a railway has been surveyed a further distance Northward of about 70 miles to Leonora, in the Mt. Margaret Goldfield. From these centres roads branch out to all the various mining centres.

The Murchison and Yalgoo Fields are connected with the port of Geraldton by Government Railways. The distance being—Geraldton to Yalgoo 183 miles, Yalgoo to Mt. Magnet 77 miles, Mt. Magnet to Cue 47 1/2 miles; from Cue a railway has been surveyed to Nannine, the distance being 49 miles. The port of Geraldton is connected with Perth by railway, a distance of 806 miles. The East Murchison Field is connected to Menzies and Mt. Magnet by well watered coach roads, a distance of about 180 and 180 miles respectively. The Peak Hill Field is connected on the Murchison Group of Goldfields being connected with the railway line by well watered roads, which is a feature of the Murchison Fields.

The Ashburton Goldfield is connected with the port of Onslow by road, about 180 miles. The Gascoyne Goldfield is connected with the port of Carnarvon by road. This field is also connected with the Murchison Fields, via Peak Hill, by road, and with the Ashburton Field by road.

The West Pilbarra and Pilbarra Goldfields are connected with the port of Cossack, 12 miles from Roebourne.

The port of Condon is situated also about 80 miles North from Marble Bar, with which it is connected by road. There is also a road about 100 miles in length to Port Hedland.

The Kimberley Goldfield is connected with the port of Wyndham, in the Cambridge Gulf, which is 200 miles North from Hall's Creek.

The Dundas Goldfield is connected by road with the port at Esperance Bay, distant about 150 miles South from Norseman Town, which is also distant 110 miles from Coolgardie. A railway is now proposed from Coolgardie to Norseman.

Donnybrook and Greenbushes are respectively 17 miles and 46 miles from Bunbury their port, which is 114 miles by rail from Perth.

Collie Coalfield is connected by a short branch line to the Perth-Bunbury railway, being distant 120 miles from Perth and 40 from Bunbury.

Northampton and Yandanooka are distant by rail 34 miles and 90 miles respectively from Geraldton, the latter being on the main line of railway from Geraldton to Perth and distant about 210 miles from Perth.

The main workings of the Phillips River Goldfield are distant from its nearest port Mary Ann Harbour 80 miles, and are also connected by road to Albany and Esperance, from which Ann Harbour is distant about 170 miles and 80 miles respectively. Steamers run weekly to Mary Ann Harbour and Albany, which port is connected with Perth by rail a distance of 860 miles.

Telegraph Stations have been established on the Kimberley Field at Hall's Creek and Derby; on Pilbarra Goldfields at Marble Bar, Bamboo Creek, Roebourne, Mallina, Towerana, Nullagine, warr. Lake Austin, Mt. Magnet, Lawlers, Lennonville, Peak Hill, Tuckanarra and Yalgoo; on Ashburton, Boulder, Menzies, Norseman, Black Flag, Bulong, Goongarrie, Mt. Leonora, Broad Arrow, Pandionia, Murrin Murrin, Kumanalling, Londonderry, Niagara, Laverton, Malcolm, Diorite, King, and at Donnybrook, Collie, Greenbushes, Northampton, Albany, Phillips River, and all the ports of the Colony previously mentioned.

The P. & O. and Orient S. S. Coy's as well as the North German Lloyd S. S. Coy's Steamers call regularly both Inwards and Outwards at Fremantle.
