PERTH HIGH SCHOOL,
 St. George's terrace, Perth.

Established under the Provisions of the High School Act, 1876.

Western Australia has no university. The Perth High School was established by statute in 1876 (40 Vic., No. 8), & has an endowment of £1,000 payable out of the general revenue. The Governors are a corporate body & are empowered to hold lands, goods & benefactions in trust for the school. They are six in number & are appointed by the Governor in Council (55 Vic., No. 25) & are endowed with power to make by-laws & regulations for the management of the school. The instruction is exclusively secular & the head master must be a graduate of a recognised University, but not a minister of religion.
