

DISTRICT ROADS BOARDS

The formation, construction, and maintenance of the public roads throughout the Colony, excepting those within the boundaries of a municipality, is intrusted to the care of local boards appointed to represent the several Road Board districts into which the Colony is divided, and which it is optional for the governor to designate, define, or alter, at any time, by notice in the Government Gazette.

Roads Boards, which must consist of seven persons, inclusive of the Chairman, whom the members choose from amongst themselves, are elected by ballot by the ratepayers in the district whose names are on the Roads Board electoral list, and each elector has a proportionate number of votes to the rateable value of the property owned or occupied by him in the district.
