GENERAL INFORMATION.

The address of the Agent-General for Western Australia is 15 Victoria street, London s.w.

(a) Free passages are given to a limited number of female domestic servants (apply to the Agent-General)

(b) Each intending emigrant must undertake to remain in the Colony for at least 12 months from the date of arrival

(c) Nominated Passages.—Assisted passages are granted to a limited number of emigrants nominated by persons in the Colony to the Colonial

Secretary. They must not exceed 35 years of age. They must in all cases be approved by the Agent-General. The nominators or the emigrants must pay £8 5s., which includes ship kit, towards their passage by direct line steamer; fares by mail steamer are higher, viz.: about £10 7s. by the Orient line. The Govt. also advances money to defray passages, from other portions of the Commonwealth, of wives and families of W.A. residents. Application must be made to Colonial Secretary's Department N.B.—All nominations lapse at the expiration of 12 months from emigrants receiving notice from the Agent-General of their having been nominated

Time. Australian standard. On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The following particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States:—

Western Australia, mean time of long. 120° E. equivalent to 8 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Greenwich

South Australia, mean time of long. 142½° E. equivalent to 9½ hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 9½ hours before Greenwich

New South Wales (Mean time of long. 150° E. equivalent to 10 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich)

Queensland (E. equivalent to 10 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich)

Tasmania (Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich)
