GENERAL INFORMATION.

The address of the Agent-General for Western Australia is 15 Victoria street, London s.w.

(a) Free passages are given to a limited number of female domestic servants, arrangements being made by the Agent-General. These passages are, however, suspended for the present

(b) Each intending emigrant must undertake to remain in the Colony for at least 12 months from the date of arrival

(c) Nominated Passages. Assisted passages are granted to a limited number of emigrants nominated to the Colonial Secretary in Perth, Western Australia, by persons residing in the State. They must not exceed 40 years of age. Emigrants must in all cases produce certificates of character and health before being approved by the Agent-General in London. The nominators or the emigrants must pay £9 10s., which includes ship kit, for open berths by mail steamer, and £11 10s. to £13 10s. for closed cabins. The Govt. also advances money to defray passages, from other portions of the Commonwealth, of wives and families of W.A. residents. Application must be made to Colonial Secretary's Department

N.B.—All nominations lapse at the expiration of 12 months from emigrants receiving notice from the Agent-General of their having been nominated

Time. Australian standard. On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The following particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States:— Western Australia, mean time of long. 120° E. equivalent to 8 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Greenwich South Australia, mean time of long. 142° E. equivalent to 9 1/2 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 9 1/2 hours before Greenwich

Mean time of long. 150° E. equivalent to 10 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich New South Wales Queensland Tasmania Victoria
