Plunge and Shower Baths. Modern Sanitary Arrangements. Well-appointed Billiard Saloon, fitted with two of Alcock's best tables.

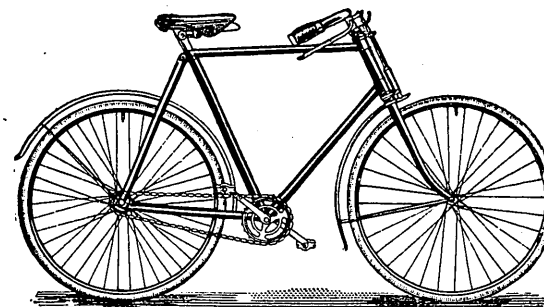
