GENERAL INFORMATION.
The address of the Agent-General
for Western Australia is 15
Victoria street, London s.w.
Nominated Passages.—Assisted
passages are granted to a
limited number of emigrants
nominated to the Colonial
Secretary in Perth, West-
ern Australia, by persons
residing in the State. They
must not exceed (if single) 45;
(if married) 50 years of
age. Emigrants must in all
cases produce certificates of
character and health before
being approved by the Agent-
General in London. The nomi-
nators or the emigrants must
pay £6 10s. which includes ship
kit, for open berths by mail
steamer, and £7 to £14 10s.
for closed cabins. The Govt.
also advances money to
defray passages, from other
portions of the Common-
wealth of wives and families
of W.A. residents. Applica-
tion must be made to Colonial
Secretary's Department.
N.B.—All nominations lapse at
the expiration of 12 months
from emigrants receiving notice
from the Agent-General of their
having been nominated
