Special exemptions.—Apparel & attire (minor articles for): Bindings & stay & boot laces (except of leather), brads, buckles & buttons (not for adornment), busk & stay fasteners, protectors & shields, bodice & skirt steels, ferrettings, filletings, hooks & eyes, tapes, webs, waddings, webbing, wire & wire ribbon; diving dresses & bags, sacks, packs & bales for bran, chaff, compressed fodder, corn, potato, onion, ore, coal & wool, also sugar mats & corn & flour sacks; woolpacks; bandages, elastic stockings, leggings, kneecaps, thigh pieces & wristlets (surgical), regalia, viz., embroidery, woven sashes, hats, (miners'), hats, minor articles for: buckles (not for adornment), pluits, helmets (firemen's); parasols, sunshades & umbrellas, minor articles for: cups, ferules, notches, ribs, rings & runners, parasol handles, fit ups mounted or not; sheathing, bunting, saddlers' webs, upholsterers' webs, collar check, saddlers' serge & felt; milling silk; horsehair cloth & hop cloth; tent & sail canvas & duck, hessians & brattice cloth; yarn, angora

Nails, n.e.i., viz., horseshoe nails, per cwt. 5s

Wire & other & spikes, staples, brads & tacks, per cwt. 3s

Weighing machines, weighbridges & scales, n.e.i., also cash registers, computing machines & attachments, ad val. 20%

Engines, ad val. 12½%

Boilers, pumps, machines & machinery, n.e.i. ad val. 12½%

\* "Wool" or "woollen" includes all manufactures from wool, hair, or fur.

Rails, fish-bolts, fish-plates, tie plates, switches, points, crossings & intersections for railways & tramways, ad val. 12½%

Rolled iron or steel beams, channels, joists, girders, columns, trough & bridge iron or steel (not dulled or further manufactured), shafting, cold rolled, turned, or planished; also bolts & nuts, ad val. 12½%

Barbed wire, ad val. 10%

Special exemptions.—Arms, viz.: rifles, military & match, including cadet rifles; agricultural machinery & implements, viz., chaff cutter knives, hand-worked cultivators, huskers & shellers, horse-rakes, lucorn bunches, maize harvesters & binders, maize huskers & shredders, mowing machines, mowers, potato raisers, rakes & ploughs combined, root cutters, straw stackers, straw-sizers & other field spraying machines, threshing machines, winnower torks (wood & steel), hand-worked seed wheel drills; apparatus (diving); crucibles; engines (fire); machinery & parts thereof, viz., automatic stokers, blowers for smelting furnaces; briquetting machinery; co'se rams or pushers, steam or hydraulic; indicators, steam engine; manganese steel parts, that is, parts which are made of steel containing not less than 7% of manganese, and that are used for and worn in grinding, crushing, or pulverizing material by coming into actual contact therewith; patent porcelain & steel rollers for flour mills; roll shells; rollers (steam rotors); turbines (steam & water); zinc retortary engines; machinery (not including motive power, zinc combination, or power connections, if any), viz., automatic canmaking and closing machines; cream separators, testers & pasteurizers; jewelers' polishing lathes, knitting, linotype, monotype, monoling & other type composing machines; log band saw mills, machinery for scouring, washing, carding, spinning, weaving & finishing the manufacture of fibrous materials, garment drafting machines, machinery for the manufacture of paper & for felting, printing machines & presses & machinery used exclusively for and in the actual process of electrotyping & stereotyping; aluminium rotary grating machines, sewing machines, soap cutting machines, stitching machines, typewriters, machine tools, as follow: bookbinding, backing, bench presses, bevelling, binding, blocking, book rolling, book rounding, case rolling, case cleaning, case making, cutting, eye-letting, embossing, finishing press & stand, folding, glueing, indexing, laying presses, nipping presses, numbering, paging, paring, perforating, punching, ruling, scoring, stand presses, stapling, trimming, wire stitching machines; bootmaking: accessories to stitching machines (being: gem insole, in-seam trimming, stitch separating; turn moulding, welt beating), button fastening, channel openers, counter, moulders, hooking, pattern cutting & grading, pegging, power hammer, prickler, fair stitch; rand counter, rand splitting, rand turning, sole rounding, standard screwing, staple fasteners, strap (printing & covering), trestling, tying (shoe), upper blocking & cleaning, vamp heading, folding & marking; brushmaking; boring, cutting, filling, flue or bottle brush machine, shaping, trimming; glue or bottle brush machine, shaping, trimming; bevelling glassmaking & working; bottlenaking, bevelling glassmaking for: standard iron frame plate glass polishers; patent presses, roughing mills, sandblasting; latmaking; hydraulic blocking press for making straw hats; India rubber working; hose machines, steel stamps, steel tyre mandrels, spreading tread drums, washer cutting; metal working: arbor or mandrel presses, hydraulic wheel presses, bolt-making, cropping cutter-making, cutters, lead & brass, tinning machines for making metallic capsules & punching & shearing machines, machine tools for electrotyping, stereotyping, and photo engraving, viz.: backing presses, bevelling, casting moulds, cold tyre setting machines,

curved cutting-off cylinder, curved finishing cylinder, curving for electroplate, electrotype, engravers' alphotographs, hydraulic moulding, presses, rotary bevellers, rotary edging machines, rotary planing machines, routing machines, shaving, squaring, trimming, facing, flanging, horseshoe, mitring, nail-making, measuring machines, profiling, riveting, rivet making, straightening, type-casting & finishing machines, washer-making, welding, wire netting, lathes, drilling, slotting, shaping, sawing, grinding, milling, key-seating, nut-finishing, tapping, screwing, planing, toothwheel or gear-cutting, forging, nutmaking, centering, chucks for lathes, blowers used for foundry & mining purposes, pneumatic hammers, steam hammers, milling machine cutters, punching & shearing machines, paper finishing, cutting, & folding; bonding & creasing, Cutting, viz.; card guillochine, label, loyer, millboard, rotary cutting & grooving, rotary cutting & scoring; damping, envelope making, glazing & hot rolling, labelling machines for coating & finishing, paper-bag & paper-box making, varnishing paper, wrapping, saddlers' harness & bag makers'; creasing, leather printing presses & plates, pinking, strapcutting, riveting, creasing, stitch-pricking, tracetracing machines & presses & dies for loops; stoneworking: litho. stone grinding; tile, pipe & brickmaking; blungers, filter presses, grinding mills (for enamels, colours, glazes & flint), magnetizer, moulding machines, press stamps, sifters, still spur & thimble presses; wood working: sawing, joining, planing, moulding, surfacing, tenoning, tongueing, & grooving, trying up, sand papering, dovetailing, mortising, boring, saw sharpening, rounding, saw brazing, spoke-making, wheel-making lathes & copying lathes & cutting & shimming; rock-boring, percussion drills; cask-making machines, viz.: rounding & balling, combined hoop-punching, shearing, spraying & bonding, stove-joining, chimeing, crozing, & dovelling; any machinery, machine tool, or any part thereof specified in any proclamation issued by the Governor-General in pursuance of a joint address passed, on the motion of Ministers by both Houses of Parliament, stating that such machinery, machine tool, or part cannot be reasonably manufactured within the Commonwealth, and that it should be admitted free; metals & manufactures of metal: aluminium, bronze, yellow metal, britannia metal, nickel & German silver, viz.: pigs, ingots, scrap, blocks, bars, strips, sheets & plates, anchors, over 10 cwt.; anodes & hooks, for plating purposes; bolts, carriage (¾ of an inch and under in diameter & 4 inches & under in length); brass, viz.: scrap, bars, sheets, pipes, tubes & strips; capsules, metallic; chains, n.e.i.; copper, viz.: strips, scrap, bars, sheets, pipes & tubes, prepared plates for engravers & lithographers; cylinders for anhydrous ammonia & for gas; discs, plough & harrow; droppers, patent steel of all lengths; electrical materials, viz.: accumulators or storage batteries, including glass cells used therewith; porcelain fittings, including lampholders (except switches over four inches in the base), insulating tapes, meters, arc lamps & accessories, resistance coils, rheostats, static transformers & terminals, cable & wire (covered), carbons, incandescent lamps, testing meters & instruments, dry cells, translators, eyelets, fasteners, machine belt; fire extinguishers, hand; iron & steel tubes or pipes (except riveted or cast), not more than 6 inches internal diameter, including flexible metal tubes, galloway & vertical parallel boiler tubes, water bore casings, wrought iron fittings for wrought iron pipes; lamps, miners' safety; last thimbles & block fasteners; leaf & foil; locks, including knobs, keys, escutcheons & staples; pins, viz.: gim, solid-headed short toilet, plain wire hair, plain safety; platinum, viz.: bars, strips, sheets, plates, retorts, pans,

condensers, tubing or pipes; printers' materials, viz.: circles, clumps, curves, knives (paring), rules, leads, slugs & type; rabbit traps, dog traps, vermin traps; rods for nail making; saddlers' tacks & nails, snaps (harness & halter), spurs & spur boxes; scales, viz.: chemical, analytical & assay; scrap iron & steel, & subject to Departmental bye-laws materials for use as scrap iron (to continue only until the coming into force of Division Via Metals); screw hooks, eyes & rings; screws (table & music stool); standards, steel facing of all lengths & pillars; steel band or ribbon, for making band saws or band knives; steel knives for tobacco cutters & tin-openers; steel, rough shaped for chaffcutter & other knives; tin-plates, plain; tinned copper sheets; tools of trade, not being machines, viz.: adzes, axes, hatchets, tomahawks & cleavers, augers & auger bits, awls & awl hafts, beavels, bookbinders' tools (including knives), bootmakers' tools (including knives), borers (angular), boxes & pins for vices, braces & bits, braces (ratchet), braziers, buffers (farriers'), bungborers, burnishers, callipers, cards (file & wool), carvers' tools, chisels & gouges, clamps, combs (graining); compasses, viz.: carpenters', coopers' & engineers'; coopers' tools, cutters (bolt, glass, mitre & pipe), diamonds (glaziers'), diggers (postholes), drills, drills (for machine use), engravers' tools, expanders (tube), fencing crimpers, files & rasps, forks (coal, coke, sluice, stone & miners'), forks (digging, hay, stable & tanners'), froes (shingle), gauges, gimlets, glaziers' tools (including knives), grafting tools, hammers (except napping, spalling, quartz, coal, brick & sledge), hoes (garden & plantation), holdfasts (bench), hooks (bush, fern, furze, hop, reep, sail, slushes, spud & weed), irons (bick, charcoal, creasing, crimping, croze, flanging, golfing, pinching, pinking, plane, saddlers', shaving & spokeshave), irons (butlers', Italian, smoothing, cloth manufacturers' & tailors'), jiggers, jointers, knives (hay, cane-cutting), lithographic tools, masons' tools, nutlocks, mill bills, mortars & pestles, miners' picks, metal-bound pick handles, moulders' tools, nail drawers (hand), needles & bodkins, painters' tools (metal), including knives, piano tuners' tools, pickers (fruit), pill rounders, pinners & nippers (end cutting), pipes—blow (for use by mouth only), planes, plasterers' tools, plates (draw & screw), pliers, presses (capsule, for bottling by hand); printers' tools, viz.: blocks for mitring, cluses, gauge & laying-on pins, galloys, gold knives, imposing surfaces, keys, levigators, metal furniture, moulds for making rollers, palette knives, quoin (metal) & locking-up apparatus, quotations, roller frames & stocks, rolls & fillets, sticks (composing, side & foot, shooting), tweezers, typeholders; punches, rakes (hand), reamers, ring sizes & sticks (metal), grippers (slaters'), rollers (grainers') & paper-lungers'), routers (wheelwrights'), rules, tapes & chains (measuring), saddlers' & harness-makers' tools (including knives), saws, scrapers (cabinet, deck, dough, horse, pig, plumbers' & tube), screws (bench), screwdrivers, seribes, scythes, sets (rivet & saw), shears, viz.: brushmakers', garden, printers', pruning, sheep & tinsmiths'; shovels & spades, sickles; smelting tools, viz.: hales, slug-scrappers & rable hales, snips (tin-smiths'), spanners, spatulas, spirit levels, spoke-snaves, shavers & spoke trimmers, squares, squeezers (cork, hand), standards (bench), stereo stocks & dies & taps for same, stops (bench), strainers (wire), stretchers (carpet & hat), supplementary moulds, tanners' & curriers' tools (including knives), tanners' squeezing machines, shaving machines & whitening & blackening machines, measuring machines, tinsmiths' tools, trammel heads or points, trowels, turners, vehicle makers' tools, viz.: counter sinks, cutters
