DISTRICT ROADS BOARDS.

**Roads.**—The roads of the State, outside of Municipalities, are under the charge of District Roads Boards, who have powers under the "Roads Act" similar to those given to Local Government Bodies in the other States. A good number of roads, however, on Goldfields where the main stock routes, of which the water supply is principal and ruling factor—passing through centre of State—are constructed and maintained at considerable cost, owing to their great length and within their district not exceeding 1s. 6d. in the £ in any one year when annual value basis is option to adopt a minimum value of 2s. 6d. on every one allotment.  
 The Roads Boards are also charged with the collection of Cart and Carriage licenses, also Dog tax, and Executive Duties of "Cart and Carriage Act," "Dog Act" and "Width of Tyres Act," also "Parks and Reserves Act," so far as it deals with Reserves under their control, and the control of water supplies along roads which are principally constructed by Works Dept. and handed over to Local Boards who control same.

The whole of the Administration of the funds voted by Parliament for roads and bridges, as well as the "Roads Act" and "Width of Tyres Act" and other matters in connection with the Roads Boards, Clerk: A. E. Sanderson; Auditors: H. J. Ash and G. D. E. Plunkett; Secretary: Roads Boards.
