Roads Boards consist of seven persons, inclusive of the Chairman, whom the members choose from amongst themselves, and are elected by ballot by the ratepayers in the district whose names are on the Roads Board electoral list. Each elector has a proportionate number of votes to the rateable value of the property owned or occupied by him in the district. Districts may be divided into wards, in which cases the Minister may increase number of members to nine. When districts are divided into wards, each elector has proportionate number of votes to rateable value of property owned or occupied by him in each ward.
