 Nominated Passengers.—Assisted passages are granted to a limited number of emigrants nominated to the Colonial Secretary in Perth, Western Australia, by persons residing in the State. They must not exceed (if single) 45 (if married) 50 years of age. Emigrants must in all cases produce certificates of character and health before being approved by the Agent-General in London. The nominators or the emigrants must

pay £6, which includes ship kit, for open berths by mail steamer, and £7 to £15 10s. for closed cabins. Advanced Passages.—N.B.—All nominations lapse at the expiration of 12 months from emigrants receiving notice from the Agent-General of their having been nominated. The Govt. also advances money to defray passages, from other portions of the Commonwealth, of wives and families of W.A. residents. Application must be made to Colonial Secretary's Office
