

# LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions the Colony is divided into six Divisions.

**South-West Division** contains 96,032 square miles, & is the most temperate part of Western Australia. It was the portion of the State first settled. It is heavily timbered in the southwest portion & well watered & capable of supporting a large population.

**Kimberley Division** contains an area of 134,995 square miles. The Kimberley Goldfields, situated at the watershed of the Fitzroy & the Ord, are within this division.

**Eastern Division** contains an area of 301,052 square miles, & comprises the far interior of the State.

**Central Division** contains an area of 150,839 square miles. The Yilgarn, Coolgardie, East Coolgardie, East Murchison & other goldfields of the Eastern Goldfield group are within this division.
