

LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions the State is divided into six Divisions.

Population at 30th Sept. 1910, 285,353.

South-West Division contains 96,032 square miles, & is the most temperate part of Western Australia. It was the portion of the State first settled. It is heavily timbered in the southwest portion & well watered & capable of supporting a large population.

Eastern Division contains an area of 301,052 square miles, & comprises the far interior of the State.

Central Division contains an area of 150,839 square miles. The Yilgarn, Coolgardie, East Coolgardie, East Murchison & other goldfields of the Eastern Goldfield group are within this division.

North-West Division contains 219,157 square miles, & is a rich pastoral division, consisting of well-grassed plains, fairly well watered. The Pilbara Goldfield is within this division.

Kimberley Division contains an area of 134,995 square miles. The Kimberley Goldfields, situated at the watershed of the Fitzroy & the Ord, are within this division.

Eucla Division contains 73,845 square miles, & contains many miles of splendid pastoral country.

Area.—The greatest length of the territory of W. A. from Cape

Londonderry in the north to West Cape Howe (south of King George's Sound) in the south, is 1,480 miles, & its breadth from Steep Point, near Dirk Hartog Island on the west, to the 129th meridian, on the east, about 1,000 miles, containing, according to the latest computations, an area of 975,920 square miles, or 624,588,500 acres.

The area of the whole of Europe is 3,823,197 square miles, whilst the grand total of the British Dominions & Protectorates is 11,334,391 square miles, & that of Great Britain & Ireland 120,840 square miles.
