 On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The following particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States:—  
 Western Australia, mean time of long. 120° E. equivalent to 8 hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Greenwich.  
 South Australia, mean time of long. 142½° E equivalent to 9½ hrs. E. of Greenwich, i.e., 9½ hours before Greenwich.
