LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions, the State is divided into six Divisions.

Population—Males, 180,679; females, 138,795; total, 319,474.

South-West Division contains 96,032 square miles, & is the most temperate part of Western Australia. It was the portion of the State first settled.

Eastern Division contains an area of 301,052 square miles, & comprises the far interior of the State.

Central Division contains an area of 150,839 square miles.

North-West Division contains 219,157 square miles, & is a rich pastoral division.

Kimberley Division contains an area of 134,995 square miles.

The Kimberley Goldfields, situated at the watershed of the Fitzroy & the Ord, are within this division.

Each Division contains 73,845 square miles, & contains many miles of splendid pastoral country.
