LOCAL GOVERNMENT

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions the State is divided into five Divisions.

Population—Males, 169,618; Females, 153,602; total, 323,220.

South-West Division contains 96,032 square miles, and is the most temperate part of Western Australia. It was the portion of the State first settled

North-West Division contains 219,157 square miles, and is a rich pastoral division.

Goldfields, situated at the watershed of the Fitzroy and the Ord, are within this division.

Eucra Division, contains 73,845 square miles, and contains many miles of splendid pastoral country.

Kimberley Division contains an area of 134,995 square miles. The Kimberley

Eastern Division contains an area of 451,881 square miles, and comprises the far Interior of the State
