

# POSTAL, TELEGRAPH & MONEY ORDERS

## Letters.

Within the Commonwealth & to all places in the British Empire, 1½d per ounce; to all other places, 3d for first oz & 1½d each additional

## Letter Cards

Within the Commonwealth—Single 1½d, reply 1½d each half To all places in the British Empire—Single 1½d each To all other places—Single 3d

## Post Cards

Within the Commonwealth and to all places in the British Empire—Single 1d, reply 1d each half To all other places—Single 1½d, reply 1½d each half

## Commercial Papers

Within the Commonwealth, New Zealand & Fiji—1d per 2 oz To all other places—1d per 2 oz, with minimum of 3d

## Printed Papers

(Including Books, Magazines, and Newspapers printed outside Australia)

Within the Commonwealth and to all places in the British Empire—1d per 4 oz To all other places—1d per 2 oz

## Patterns and Samples

Within the Commonwealth and to all places in the British Empire—1d per 2 oz To all other places—1d per 2 oz, with minimum of 2d

## Merchandise

Within the Commonwealth, New Zealand and Fiji—1d per 2 oz To all other places—Parcels rates apply

## Books

Within the Commonwealth—(a) Books printed in Australia, except as prescribed, 1d per 8oz (b) Books printed outside Australia—Printed papers rate applies. To all other places—Printed papers rate applies

## Catalogues

Within the Commonwealth—(a) Catalogues wholly set up and printed in Australia—1d per 4 oz (b) Catalogues printed outside Australia—Printed papers rate applies. To all other places—all catalogues—Printed papers rate applies

## Magazines

Within the Commonwealth—(a) Magazines printed in Australia, for each magazine—1d per 8 oz (b) Magazines printed outside Australia—Printed papers rate applies To all other places—Printed papers rate applies

## Newspapers

(Registered Newspapers printed in Aust) Commonwealth, New Zealand, & Fiji—Each newspaper, 1d per 10 oz United Kingdom—Each newspaper up to 4 oz 1d, 4 oz to 10 oz 1½d, each additional 4 oz 1d \*

(\*On packages containing more than one newspaper the postage shall not

be higher than that chargeable on a package of printed papers of the same weight)

United Kingdom, by all sea route—Each newspaper, 1½d per 16 oz; Via America 1d per 4 oz

Other places in British Empire—1d per 4 oz

United States of America—Each newspaper, 1d per 4 oz

All other places—1d per 2 oz

## Parcels

Within any State—6d for first lb & 3d each additional lb up to 11 lb

Interstate, Papua, New Zealand, Fiji—3d for first lb & 6d each additional lb up to 11 lb

United Kingdom—1/4 for first lb & 6d each additional lb up to 11 lb

## Registered Letters.

Registration fee, 3d (in addition to the ordinary postage)

## Money Orders

Rates of Commission on Money Orders. Commonwealth—6d for each £5 or fraction thereof

New Zealand—3d for each £1 or fraction thereof with a minimum of 6d

Fiji, Papua & Mandated Territories—4d for each £1 or fraction thereof, with a minimum of 6d

United Kingdom, British Possessions, & Foreign Countries not separately shown—6d for each £1 with a minimum of 9d

United States of America—9d for first £2 and 4d for each additional £1 or fraction thereof

Philippine Islands—6/ for first £1 and 7d for each 2/ or fraction thereof

Note:—In the case of United States of America and Canada payment is made in dollars and cents at the conversion rate ruling at the time of issue. This rate is altered from time to time. In the case of foreign countries with which the Commonwealth has no direct exchange, the London office makes a charge of 2d in the £ with a minimum charge of 4d. This amount is charged to the remitter in addition to the ordinary commission

Postal Notes—Payable throughout the Commonwealth & in Papua the postage is as follows: On 6d the postage is 1d; on 1/-, 3d; on 1/6, 1d; on 2/-, 1d; on 2/6 up to 4/6, 1d; on 5/-, 1½d; on 7/6, 2d; on 10/-, 2d; on 20/-, 3d.

## Telegraphic

All telegraph offices are notified as such in the Towns portion of the Directory

Rates—Central and suburban (15 miles radius), 10 words and under, 9d; each additional word, 1d. Beyond the 15-mile radius, 10 words and under, 1/-; each additional word 1d. Sundays, Christmas Day & Good Friday, and between 6 p.m. and 7 a.m., double rates.

Press messages for publication, 25 words and under, 6d; 25 to 50, 11d; 60 to 100, 1/9; each additional 50, 8d; Interstate, double rates

Interstate, 10 words, 1/4; each additional word after 10 words, 1d; Sundays, Christmas Day, and Good Friday, 16 words, 2/8; each additional word 2d

Urgent telegrams, double the above

To New Zealand, 4½d per word.

To London, 3/- per word

To Europe, 3/-; Aden, 2/6; Hong Kong, 2/8; India, 2/6; Japan, 3/5; Singapore, 2/6; Egypt, 3/5 to 3/6; Capetown, 2/8.

Ceylon—2/6; Jamaica, 4/1; California, 2/4; New York, 2/8 each word

Telegraphic money orders made payable at any money order office, which is also a telegraph office in Tasmania, New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, Victoria, Western Australia & New Zealand,\* on payment of a message of 10 words, in addition to the money order commission

\*Remitter required to advise payee by wire

Lettergrams are accepted for transmission between the hours of 7 pm and midnight at the principal offices. Rate is 30 words 1/3, and 1d every additional word

## Week-end Cable Letters

(Liable to suspension from time to time) Week-end cable letters may be exchanged between the Commonwealth and the United Kingdom, &c. and they shall be subject to the rules as deferred telegrams, with the exception that they shall be delivered on Tuesday morning, or, if practicable, on Monday.

Week-end cable letters shall be transmitted by telegraph throughout, except in the case of those intended for onward transmission by post from the telegraph office of destination in the United Kingdom or Canada to other countries. The prefix "TWT" is to be included in the address, and charged for as one word.
