 such skins must be accompanied by a
 statutory declaration declaring the

 siding at Gutha, on the Wongan Hills-
 Mullewa Railway Line.
 Any grey kangaroo skins forwarded
 or consigned to any centre South of
 Geraldton prior to the payment of
 royalty will be charged the
 royalty as prescribed for grey kanga-

roo skins taken South of a line fol-
 lowing the railway line from Dong-
 arra to Mingenew, and thence to
 the railway siding at Gutha
 (Units, 10/- per annum)

INCOME TAX.
 The rates of Income Tax in the 2 on
 the income chargeable are graduated
 being 2d. up to the first £100 income
 chargeable; 2.007d on £101; 2.014d on
 £102, and so on, increasing by
 regular increments of .007d with
 every increase of £1 in the income
 chargeable, until the rate reaches 4/
 in the 2, namely on 26872. There
 after the rate is 4/- uniformly;
 rates of tax subject to 33 1-3 re-
 bate; companies 1/3, plus 15 per
 cent super tax
