Western Australia, mean time of long, 120 deg E, equivalent to 8 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Green-

South Australia, mean time of long, 1421 deg E, equivalent to 91 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 91 hours before Greenwich

Tasmania, Victoria, N S W & Queensland, mean time of long, 150 deg E, equivalent to 10 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich

New Zealand, mean time of long, 172-deg E, equivalent to 11½ hrs. E of Greenwich
