INCOME TAX.

The rates of Income Tax in the 2 on the income chargeable are graduated being 2d. up to the first £100 income chargeable; 2.007d on £101; 2.014d on £102, and so on, increasing by regular increments of 0.07d with every increase of £1 in the income chargeable, until the rate reaches 4/ in the £, namely on £6672. Thereafter the rate is 4/- uniformly; rates of tax subject to 33 1-3 rebate; companies 1/3, plus 15 per cent super tax

This amount is charged to the remitter in addition to the ordinary commission

Week-end cable letters may be exchanged between the Commonwealth and the United Kingdom, &c, and they shall be subject to the rules as deferred telegrams, with the exception that they shall be delivered on Tuesday morning, or, if practicable, on Monday. Week-end cable letters shall be transmitted by telegraph throughout, except in the case of those intended for onward transmission by post from the telegraph office of destination in the United Kingdom or Canada to other countries. The prefix "TWT" is to be included in the address, and charged for as one word.
