square miles, and is the most tem-
perate part of Western Australia. It
was the portion of the State first
settled.

Eastern Division contains an area of
451,650 square miles, and comprises

the far interior of the State
North-West Division contains 216,275
square miles, and is a rich pastoral
division.

Kimberley Division contains an area of
133,340 square miles. The Kimberley
Goldfields, situated at the watershed

of the Fitzroy and the Ord, are within
this Division.

Eucla Division contains 76,350 square
miles, and contains many miles of
splendid pastoral country.

(624,588,800 acres)
