### INCOME TAX.

The rates of Income Tax in the £ on the income chargeable are graduated being 2d. up to the first £100 income chargeable; 2.007d on £101; 2.014d on £102. and so on, increasing by regular increments of .007d with every increase of £1 in the income chargeable, until the rate reaches 4/ in the £, namely on 26672. Thereafter the rate is 4/- uniformly; rates of tax subject to 33 1-3 rebate; companies 1/3, plus 15 per cent super tax

Week-end cable letters shall be transmitted by telegraph throughout, except in the case of those intended for onward transmission by post from the telegraph office of destination in the United Kingdom or Canada to other countries. Such letters shall be charged for as one word.
