Australian Standard. On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The fol-lowing particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States :--

Western Australia, mean time of long, 120 deg E, equivalent to 8 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Green-

South Australia, mean time of long, 1421 deg E, equivalent to 91 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 91 hours before

Greenwich Tasmania, Victoria, N S W & Queensland, mean time of long, 150 deg E, equivalent to 10 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich

New Zealand, mean time of long, 172 deg E, equivalent to 111 hrs, E of Greenwich
