Time.  
Australian Standard.

On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The following particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States:—

Western Australia, mean time of long, 120 deg E, equivalent to 8 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Greenwich

South Australia, mean time of long, 142½ deg E, equivalent to 9½ hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 9½ hours before Greenwich

Tasmania, Victoria, N S W & Queensland, mean time of long, 150 deg E, equivalent to 10 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich

New Zealand, mean time of long, 172 deg E, equivalent to 11½ hrs. E of Greenwich

Western Australia, mean time of long, 120 deg E, equivalent to 8 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 8 hours before Greenwich

South Australia, mean time of long, 142½ deg E, equivalent to 9½ hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 9½ hours before Greenwich

Tasmania, Victoria, N S W & Queensland, mean time of long, 150 deg E, equivalent to 10 hrs E of Greenwich, i.e., 10 hours before Greenwich

New Zealand, mean time of long, 172 deg E, equivalent to 11½ hrs. E of Greenwich
