LOCAL GOVERNMENT

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions the States divided into five Divisions.

Population as at 31st March, 1938: Males, 241,980; Females, 216,473. Total: 458,453.

South West Division contains 89,305
square miles, and is the most temper-
ate part of Western Australia. It
is the portion of the State first settled,
& is devoted mainly to mixed farming,
wheat-growing, dairying, forestry &
fruit-growing

Eastern Division, where the principal
goldfields are situated contains an area
of 451,650 square miles, and comprises

the far interior of the State.
North West Division contains 216,275
square miles, and is a rich, pastoral
division, embracing also important
metalliferous country

Kimberley Division contains an area of
133,340 square miles, and includes
large tracts of excellent cattle coun-
try as well as extensive sheep runs,

The Kimberley Goldfields, situated at
the watershed of the Fitzroy & Ord
rivers, are within this division

Euelia Division contains 76,350 square
miles, including extensive areas of
splendid pastoral country and some
wheat land
