 20 acres, £2; over 20 acres to 30  
 acres, £3; over 30 acres an additional  
 £1 for every 10 acres or part thereof,  
 in excess of 30 acres

Publican's general license: (a) For any  
 house or premises situated within a  
 municipality; (b) if the annual value  
 of the house or premises does not  
 exceed £500, £50; (c) if the annual  
 value of the house or premises exceeds  
 £500, £75; (d) if the house or premises  
 exceeds £1000, £100; (e) For any  
 house or premises not situated within  
 a municipality; (f) if the annual value  
 of the house or premises does not  
 exceed £200, £40; (g) if the annual  
 value of the house or premises exceeds

### DEFINITIONS

City & Suburban Properties (Leasehold  
 or Freehold) & Businesses—For the  
 purpose of this Scale of Minimum  
 Charges, city & suburban properties  
 (leasehold or freehold) & businesses  
 are defined as all those within a radius  
 of 14 miles from Perth and/or Free  
 Town Halls, excepting those under the  
 following definition of country prop-  
 erties

Country Properties & Businesses—Country  
 properties are defined as all those  
 wherever situated when such are used  
 for grazing, agricultural, orchard,  
 poultry, and/or general cultivation  
 purposes, & also all other properties  
 situated outside a radius of 14 miles  
 from Perth and/or Free Town Halls

Sales (Auction or Private Treaty) of City  
 & Suburban Properties (leasehold or  
 freehold) & Businesses—Not exceeding  
 £500, 5%; exceeding £500, but not  
 £3,000, 5% on first £500 & 2½% on  
 residue; exceeding £3,000, but not  
 £20,000, 5% on first £500, 2½% on  
 next £2,500, & 1½% on residue; ex-  
 ceeding £20,000, 5% on first £500,  
 2½% on next £2,500, 1½% on next  
 £17,000 & 1% on residue

Minimum fee, leasehold and/or freehold  
 property, £2/2/-; for the sale of a  
 business, £5

In the case of an auction the above fees  
 shall not include advertising, which  
 shall be paid by the vendor whether  
 the property is sold or not

When several properties are offered at  
 auction for one Vendor at the same  
 sale, commission shall be charged on  
 the total amount of the sales effected  
 at the auction as though it were one  
 sale. On properties sold privately  
 after the auction a separate commis-  
 sion in accordance with the above scale  
 shall be charged on each property so  
 sold

Where a property and/or business which  
 includes freehold or leasehold land and  
 chattels is sold on a walk-in walk-out  
 basis, commission shall be charged on  
 the whole as one entity

Sales of Country Properties & Businesses  
 —Not exceeding £1,000, 5%; exceed-  
 ing £1,000, but not £3,500, 5% on  
 first £1,000 and 2½% on residue;  
 exceeding £3,500, but not £20,000,  
 5% on first £1,000, 2½% on next  
 £2,500 & 1½% on the next £16,500;  
 exceeding £20,000, 5% on first £1,000,  
 2½% on next £2,500, 1½% on next  
 £16,500 & 1% on residue

Hotel Leases, Furniture, Incoming &  
 Goodwill

On Sale of Lease or arranging Lease  
 for Owner of Freehold—Within the  
 City & Suburban Area, 5% on the  
 value of the ingoing and/or furniture  
 up to £500, and 2½% on the residue.  
 Outside the City & Suburban Area 5%  
 on the value of the ingoing and/or  
 furniture up to £1,000, & 2½% on  
 the residue, together with, in each  
 case, 5% on the first year's rental &  
 1% on each additional year's rental or  
 part thereof on the term stipulated in  
 the lease

On Sale of an Interest in a Lease or  
 Arranging a Sub-Lease—Within the  
 City & Suburban Area 5% on the  
 value of the ingoing and/or furniture  
 up to £500, and 2½% on the residue.  
 Outside the City & Suburban Area 5%  
 on the value of the ingoing and/or  
 furniture up to £1,000, & 2½% on  
 the residue, together with, in the event  
 of an increase of rental over and  
 above that paid by the Vendor Lessee,  
 5% on the first year's increase of  
 rental and 1% on each additional  
 year's increase of rental for the term  
 of the lease or sub-lease

Sales (by Auction or Private Treaty) of  
 Live Stock

Fat Stock (Sheep & Cattle)—Country,  
 5%; Metro, 4%; Store Stock (Sheep  
 & Cattle), 5%; Pigs, 5%; Dairy Cattle  
 & Horses, 5%; Conjunction Sales, 6%.  
 Terms on Fat Stock sold in metro area,  
 3 days

Valuations of City, Suburban & Country  
 Town Properties

The fee shall be, when the value does  
 not exceed £500, £2/2/-; over £500  
 and not exceeding £1,000, £3/3/-;  
 thence a half-guinea for each £500  
 in value up to £10,000; & then from  
 £10,000, a half-guinea for each  
 £1,000 in value. Minimum charge,  
 £2/2-/. Travelling & out-of-pocket  
 expenses to be added in all cases

 amounts up to £5,000, £4/4/-; on  
 amounts up to £10,000, £5/5/-;  
 amounts over £10,000, for each  
 £1,000, 10/6, with a maximum of  
 £52/10/-

 purchase or sale of Stocks & Shares  
 may be charged, but such charge must  
 not be covered by an increase or  
 reduction in the price

No other rates than those above fixed  
 shall be charged to the purchaser or  
 vendor, and no allowance by way of  
 rebate, return commission, or other-  
 wise, shall be made except to members  
 of recognised Exchanges, to recognised  
 stock & sharebrokers in places where  
 no Exchange exists, or to bona-fide
