Auction (sell by), from £5 to £25 per annum each, according to locality. A licensed auctioneer may sell by deputy, for seven days, on payment of 21/-.

Fishing Boat, £1 per year boats up 24ft; £2 per year exceeding 24ft; ½ fee after 30th June

Fisherman, 10/- per year, 5/- if taken out after 30th June

Gallon License, £15 per annum

Game Act—(a) To take or kill kangaroos for food purposes only, free; (b) to take or kill marsupials for purpose of selling, free; (c) to take or kill native game (excepting marsupials) for selling, £2 per annum; (d) to sell marsupials, £5 per annum (after 30th June 50/-); (e) to sell native game other than marsupials, £1 per annum

Opossum skins, 9d; grey kangaroo skins 1s & 4½ according to where taken from in the State

Red kangaroo skins & Euro skins are royalty free; Brush kangaroos 1d.

Other skins—skins taken outside Kimberley Division ½d, within the Kimberley Division free

Gun (to possess), 5/s per annum; 1/- per annum renewals

Hospitals (private), 10/- per annum

Motor waggons & vans—Not exceeding 25 P.L.W., 70/-; rising on a graduated scale, viz., Horse Power plus weight of vehicle unladen, plus load

Motor Drivers Licenses, 5/- per annum, but applicant must go through a driving test before first issue is granted

Motor Cycles—£1

Motor Cycle & Sidecar—£1/10/-

Motor Cycle & Box Carrier—£2/10/- (minimum)

Noxious trades—artificial manure, blood drying, bonemill, chemical wks, fell-mongers, gutscrapping, sausage skins, soap & candle, & wool scourers, £5. Fat melting, flock factories, marine store, storing bones, rag & bone mchrs, tanneries & tripe boiling & cleaning, cleaners (dry), dye works, fish curing, fish shops, jute stores, fat rendering (butchers' shops), & laundries—maximum £5 per annum

Orchards, Annual Fees—Under one acre, 1/-; over one acre, 2/- per acre; orchards & vineyards less than 4 yrs of age, 1/-; maximum registration fee for vine grapes, £3/-; nurseries 1/-.

Packet license, £10 per annum

Pawnbrokers, £10 per annum

Pearl dealers, general, £50; Sharks Bay (general) £20, (limited) £5 or as fixed by the Minister from time to time

Pearl divers, 6/8 per term (4 months, or as fixed by the Minister from time to time)

Pearl divers (tender), 0/8 per term (4 months)

Pearling Engine Boat, £10 per annum, or as fixed by the Minister from time to time

Pearling (general), £1 for 3 months

Pearling—Permit for employment of an additional man under a general license, 5/- for 3 months

Pearling—Registration fee for change of, or additional place of business of licensed pearl dealer, 5/- per annum

Pearling—Beach Combers, £4 per annum; shell buyers, £3 per annum; pearl cleaners, £5 per annum

Pearl Ship License (transfer of): 10/- per annum

Publican's general license: (a) For any house or premises situated within a municipality; (i) if the annual value of the house or premises does not exceed £500, £50; (ii) if the annual value of the house or premises exceeds £500, £75; if the house or premises exceeds £1000, £100; (b) For any house or premises not situated within a municipality; (i) if the annual value of the house or premises does not exceed £200, £40; (ii) if the annual value of the house or premises exceeds £200, £50. These are the minimum annual fees

Secondhand Dealer, 5/- per annum

Ship License, see Pearl Ship License

Ship Engine Boats (Pearl), License £10 per annum per boat, or as fixed by the Minister from time to time

Hand Pump Ship, £4 per annum or as fixed by the Minister from time to time

"Shops," including boarding houses, registration fees from 2/6 to 50/-, according to number of persons employed

Slaughter Houses, Maximum £5 per annum

Scale Repairer, 5/-

Spirit merchants, £30 per annum within 15 miles of G.P.O.; £20 per annum elsewhere

Stallions, up to 5 years—Annual Inspection Fee £1 per annum; Annual Registration Fee £1/1/- per annum; 5 years & over, One Inspection Fee, £1; one Registration Fee (Life) £1/1/-

Steamer, vessel or boat over 15 tons for hire, or held or let for hire or reward, 20/- per annum; not exceeding 15 tons, let for hire, 10/-; & not exceeding 15 tons, held or let for hire or reward, 2/6

Stock Food or Lick, 10/- each per annum

Surveyor's License, £2/12/- on original issue—no annual charge

Warehouses, registration fees from 2/6 to 50/-, according to number of persons employed

Wayside house license, £15 per annum

Yachts—7/6; Rowing Boats 5/- (including Survey Fees of 5/- & 2/6 respectively)

## Commercial Charges

On purchase or sale of Ships, unless otherwise arranged, 5%

On private sales of Merchandise, 5%. (On del credere, when incurred, 2½% additional)

On sales of Wool—first £200, 3%; over £200, up to £500, 2%; over £500, 1½%. Receiving, weighing, warehousing, allotting, re-packing, sample bales, sales expenses, etc., ¼d per lb. Storage: First 90 days free, thereafter 1d per bale per week. Fire ins, 1/- per month

On sales of Tallow & Sheepskins, Hides, Marsupial Skins, Bark, 5%

On consigned Merchandise, withdrawn, re-shipped or transferred on invoice value, 2½%; on purchases of Merchandise with funds, 2½% without funds, 5% on first £500, residue 2½%

### DEFINITIONS

City & Suburban Properties (Leasehold or Freehold) & Businesses—For the purpose of this Scale of Minimum Charges, city & suburban properties (leasehold or freehold) & businesses are defined as all those within a radius of 14 miles from Perth and/or Fre Town Halls, excepting those under the following definition of country properties

Country Properties & Businesses—Country properties are defined as all those wherever situated when such are used for grazing, agricultural, orchard, poultry, and/or general cultivation purposes, & also all other properties situated outside a radius of 14 miles from Perth and/or Fre Town Halls

Sales (Auction or Private Treaty) of City & Suburban Properties (leasehold or freehold) & Businesses—Not exceeding £500, 5%; exceeding £500, but not £3,000, 5% on first £500 & 2½% on residue; exceeding £3,000, but not £20,000, 5% on first £500, 2½% on next £2,500, & 1½% on residue exceeding £20,000, 5% on first £500, 2½% on next £2,500, 1½% on next £17,000 & 1% on residue

Minimum fee, leasehold and/or freehold property, £5/5/-; for the sale of a business, £5

In the case of an auction the above fees shall not include advertising, which shall be paid by the vendor whether the property is sold or not

When several properties are offered at auction for one Vendor at the same sale, commission shall be charged on the total amount of the sales effected at the auction as though it were one sale. On properties sold privately after the auction a separate commission in accordance with the above scale shall be charged on each property so sold

Where a property and/or business which includes freehold or leasehold land and chattels is sold on a walk-in walk-out basis, commission shall be charged on the whole as one entity

Sales of Country Properties & Businesses—Not exceeding £1,000, 5%; exceeding £1,000, but not £3,500, 5% on first £1,000 and 2½% on residue; exceeding £3,500, but not £20,000, 5% on first £1,000, 2½% on next £2,500 & 1½% on the next £16,500; exceeding £20,000, 5% on first £1,000, 2½% on next £2,500, 1½% on next £16,500 & 1% on residue

Other conditions same as for City & Suburban Properties

Hotel Leases, Furniture, Incoming & Goodwill

On Sale of Lease or arranging Lease for Owner of Freehold—Within the City & Suburban Area, 5% on the value of the ingoing and/or furniture up to £500, and 2½% on the residue. Outside the City & Suburban Area 5% on the value of the ingoing and/or furniture up to £1,000, & 2½% on the residue, together with, in each case, 5% on the first year's rental & 1% on each additional year's rental or part thereof on the term stipulated in the lease

On Sale of an Interest in a Lease or Arranging a Sub-Lease—Within the City & Suburban Area 5% on the value of the ingoing and/or furniture up to £500, and 2½% on the residue. Outside the City & Suburban Area 5% on the value of the ingoing and/or furniture up to £1,000, & 2½% on the residue, together with, in the event of an increase of rental over and above that paid by the Vendor Lessee, 5% on the first year's increase of rental and 1% on each additional year's increase of rental for the term of the lease or sub-lease

Sales (by Auction or Private Treaty) of Live Stock

Fat Stock (Sheep & Cattle)—Country, 5%; Metro, 4%; Store Stock (Sheep & Cattle), 5%; Pigs, 5%; Dairy Cattle & Horses, 5%; Conjunction Sales, 6%. Terms on Fat Stock sold in metro area, 3 days

Valuations of City, Suburban & Country Town Properties

The fee shall be, when the value does not exceed £500, £3/3/-; over £500 and not exceeding £1,000, £4/4/-; thence a half-guinea for each £500 in value up to £10,000; & then from £10,000, a half-guinea for each £1,000 in value. Minimum charge, 3/3/- Travelling & out-of-pocket expenses to be added in all cases

### Brokerage Rates

Maximum brokerage for selling or buying Stocks & Shares in cases where members of recognised Exchanges are employed as Brokers

On Bank Deposits, 1%; Govt Stock Treasury Bills & Municipal Debentures of every description, ¼%; Mining & other Debentures, 1%

Shares bought or sold up to 6d per share inclusive, ¼d per share; over 6d & up to 3/- inclusive, 1d per share; over 3/- & up to 5/-, 1½d; over 5/- & up to 10/-, 2d; over 10/- & up to 15/-, 3d; over 15/- & up to 20/-, 4d; over 20/- & up to 40/-, 6d; over 40/- & up to 60/-, 9d; over 60/- & up to £5, 1/-; over £5 & up to £7/10/-, 1/3; over £7/10/- & up to £10, 1/6; over £10 & up to £15, 2/-; over £15 & up to £20, 2/6; over £20, 1%

Syndicate Shares—Up to £10 inclusive, 10/-; up to £25 inclusive, 15/-; up to £50 inclusive, 20/-; up to £75, 30/-; up to £100, 40/-; over £100, 2%

Maximum fees for Valuations—On amounts up to £100, at discretion; on amount up to £500, £1/1/-; on amounts up to £1,000, £2/2/-; on amounts up to £3,000, £3/3/-; on amounts up to £5,000, £4/4/-; on amounts up to £10,000, £5/5/-; amounts over £10,000, for each £1,000, 10/6, with a maximum of £52/10/-

All costs out of pocket entailed in the purchase or sale of Stocks & Shares may be charged, but such charge must not be covered by an increase or reduction in the price

No other rates than those above fixed shall be charged to the purchaser or vendor, and no allowance by way of rebate, return commission, or otherwise, shall be made except to members of recognised Exchanges, to recognised stock & sharebrokers in places where no Exchange exists, or to bona-fide agents
