

ARCHBISHOP RILEY. ANGLICAN CHURCH, PERTH

Records relating to Charles Owen Leaver Riley, Archbishop of Perth.

Charles Owen Leaver Riley was born on 26 May 1854 in England. After serving curacies in York and Manchester, he was appointed rector of St. Paul's, Preston in 1885. In 1886 he served concurrently as surrogate to the bishop of Manchester. He arrived in Western Australia in 1895, having received an offer of the bishopric of Perth. Later he was elected as the first Archbishop of Perth. He died on 21 June 1929.
