This Register of Baptisms, consisting of loose sheets, unbound begins 10 May 1873. The first entry is numbered 619. It was kept by Joseph Withers, down to 20 September 1876. A few entries follow (Dec 17 to 3 July 1877, unsigned). Then there is a blank till 28 February 1889, when RR Furnell continues it, till 28 February 1889. John Brand follows (3 March 1889 to 21 October 1889) when Withers continues again till March 22, 1891. Joseph Withers was Rector of Bunbury and Colonial Chaplain from 1864 to 1892. From 1880 to 1889, Purnell was Priest in charge of Bunbury, while Withers carried on work at The Williams. The Wellington District covered Bunbury, Picton, Australind, Capel, Collie, Brunswick, Williams, Blackwood, Ferguson, Minninup, The Warren, Boyanup, Preston, Wokalup, Harvey, Roelands, Bridgetown
