

BUSSELL, Alfred Pickmore (1814-1882)

Alfred Pickmore Bussell, born 21 June 1814, was the sixth son of Rev. William Marchant and Frances Louisa Bussell (nee Yates). He arrived in Western Australia aboard the Warrior on 12 March 1830. He married Ellen Heppingstone on 27 August 1850 and they had thirteen children. He worked on the family properties at Augusta and then Vasse, followed by Ellensbrook and finally Wallcliffe in the Margaret River area. He died on 18 October 1882. Some documentation shows Alfred's birth being 1816 but a copy of his baptismal entry in St Mary's Portsea Church baptismal register clearly states that both the birth and Baptism occurred in 1814.
