

**COOKWORTHY, Frances Glasford (1834-1928)**

Frances Glasford Cookworthy was the daughter of Charlotte Cookworthy (later Bussell). At some time in her girlhood she was back in England and returned again to Western Australia on the ship *Gwalior* in 1856. On 10 September 1873 she married her cousin Joseph Cookworthy. He died at Busselton in 1909. There were no children. Collection includes 2 letters in Joseph Cookworthy's handwriting.
