The lodge was consecrated on 15 April 1929 by the Deputy Grand Master R.W. Bro. A.C. McCallum, in the Masonic Hall, Temple Street, Victoria Park. The Wiluna Lodge no. 153 WAC amalgamated with the Prince of Wales Lodge on 30 October 1997, under the title of The Prince of Wales, Wiluna Lodge, no.144 WAC. The Prince of Wales, Wiluna Lodge no 144 WAC surrendered its warrant of constitution on 12 November 2005.
