

## FREMANTLE CIRCUIT. METHODIST CHURCH

The Fremantle Circuit included North Fremantle and South Fremantle; also Hilton Park, Spearwood and White Gum Valley until the formation of the Hilton Circuit in 1962. South Fremantle was a separate circuit from 1901 to 1928.

In 1923 the Fremantle Circuit was granted the status of Central Methodist Mission. Since June 1977 the Circuit has been a parish of the Uniting Church in Australia.

### Restrictions
