GILCHRIST, Roma and John

John Gilchrist was born on 8 October 1910 and died on 14 December 1983. His wife, Roma, was born on 1 September 1909 and died on October 1983. From the 1940's Roma and John Gilchrist were greatly involved in unionism, communism, the movements for peace and women's rights. They wrote short stories, plays, and poems. They put together materials for the history of the movements and activities of unions in Western Australia. A photographer and a dancer, John was an active member of the Workers Art Guild as well as the Social Club. He was also a stage director. In photography, he was interested in producing and portraying Union demonstrations as they happened so that such events could be remembered.
