

**CHURCH MISSIONARY SOCIETY, WESTERN AUSTRALIA INC.**

A society within the Anglican Church of Australia

The Church Missionary Society was founded in England in 1799 within the Church of England. The Australian Branch of the Society, which became the Church Missionary Society of Australia and Tasmania, was founded in 1825. Areas in which the Australian Society has missionary work includes North Australia, East Africa, India, Bangladesh, Malaysia, Sri Lanka and Hong Kong.

For a number of years the Western Australian Committee of the Society had a full time clerical organizing secretary. In 1958, a provincial Missionary Council for the Anglican Province of Western Australia was formed to co-ordinate the Church's support of the two principal Anglican missionary bodies, the Church Missionary Society and the Australian Board of Missions. Thereafter the Committee had an Honorary Secretary. In 1976 the Council was renamed The Western Australian Association of the Church Missionary Society of Australia, Incorporated
