

WARREN FAMILY PAPERS

John Warren (1783-1873) from Morayshire, Scotland arrived in Adelaide in January 1838 on the ship 'Royal Admiral', followed by his wife and family in 1840. Their son, John Warren II, (1830-1914), a member of the Legislative Council in South Australia, had married Margaret Hogarth, had twelve children who grew up on their property 'Springfield' near Williamstown in South Australia.

John Warren II came to Western Australian in 1898 to select land for his family at east Cobline. On his return to South Australia where he had pastoral interests, three of his eight sons came to WA to take possession of and clear their blocks of land for farming. One of these sons, John Campbell Warren (1866-1947) known as Jack, had married Lillie May Dale (1870-1957) in Adelaide, 1895 and she and their infant son John Campbell Dale Warren (1896-1918) came to Western Australian in July 1899 to live of their property 'Dyliabing'.

John and Lillie Warren had another five children all born in WA: Margaret Dale (1899-1991) aka Meg, Gilbert Dunbar (1901-1973), Jessie Grant (1902-1992), Barbara Claire (1904-1991) and Cicely Noel (1906-1996). Their first son John Campbell served in the 16th Battalion Infantry as a Private during World War I and was killed in action on August 16, 1918, near Guillaucourt, France.

A hand-written account of the family's time in Dyliabing, written by Cicely Blackall, is included in this collection at 'reminiscences' ACC 5021A/7

This collection spans three generations of the Warren Family, from John Warren, John Campbell Warren and his children, John Campbell Dale, Gilbert Dunbar, and Cicely Noel.
