WHITFELD, Miles, 1903-1997 WHITFELD, Ivan, 1904-1983

Miles Whitfeld, a mechanical engineer, arrived in Western Australia aboard the *TSS Moreton Bay* on 12 March 1926. He was met in Perth by his brother, Ivan. The brothers contracted work in Grass Valley, then moved to Southern Cross, where Miles worked and lived in the railway construction camp at Norseman.

Miles wrote many letters to his mother in England, telling her in great detail about his way of living, his work, the fauna and flora and many other items of interest. He describes how they set up a tent to live in while they were working in the bush and how he made camp beds and a larder. Later in the year when he worked on the railway at Norseman, his letters are illustrated with delightful sketches of railway trains and equipment.

The collection contains a few short letters from Miles to his mother which were written from 1926-1927 and one in 1935 when Miles was working on the Canning Dam construction. Photographs taken by Miles Whitfeld can be located in the Battye Pictorial Collection.
